## Wrongful Death

The Wrongful Death Life Activity Calendar© is a custom, three-panel chart, available in three sizes, that graphically summarizes the lifestyle changes that occur in situations involving wrongful death.











A simple checklist helps gather information about the person's activities with their loved ones, before death. Based on this information, the Wrongful Death Life Activity Calendar compares typical **before** and **after** years to illustrate the impact of the wrongful death *on the survivors*.

The Wrongful Death Life Activity Calendar powerfully summarizes the permanent debilitating effect of a death on the survivors. The Life Activity Calendar speaks even when the decedent cannot, graphically illustrating the loss that the survivors have suffered and what the Jury Instruction tasks the jury to compensate.

# Life Activity Key

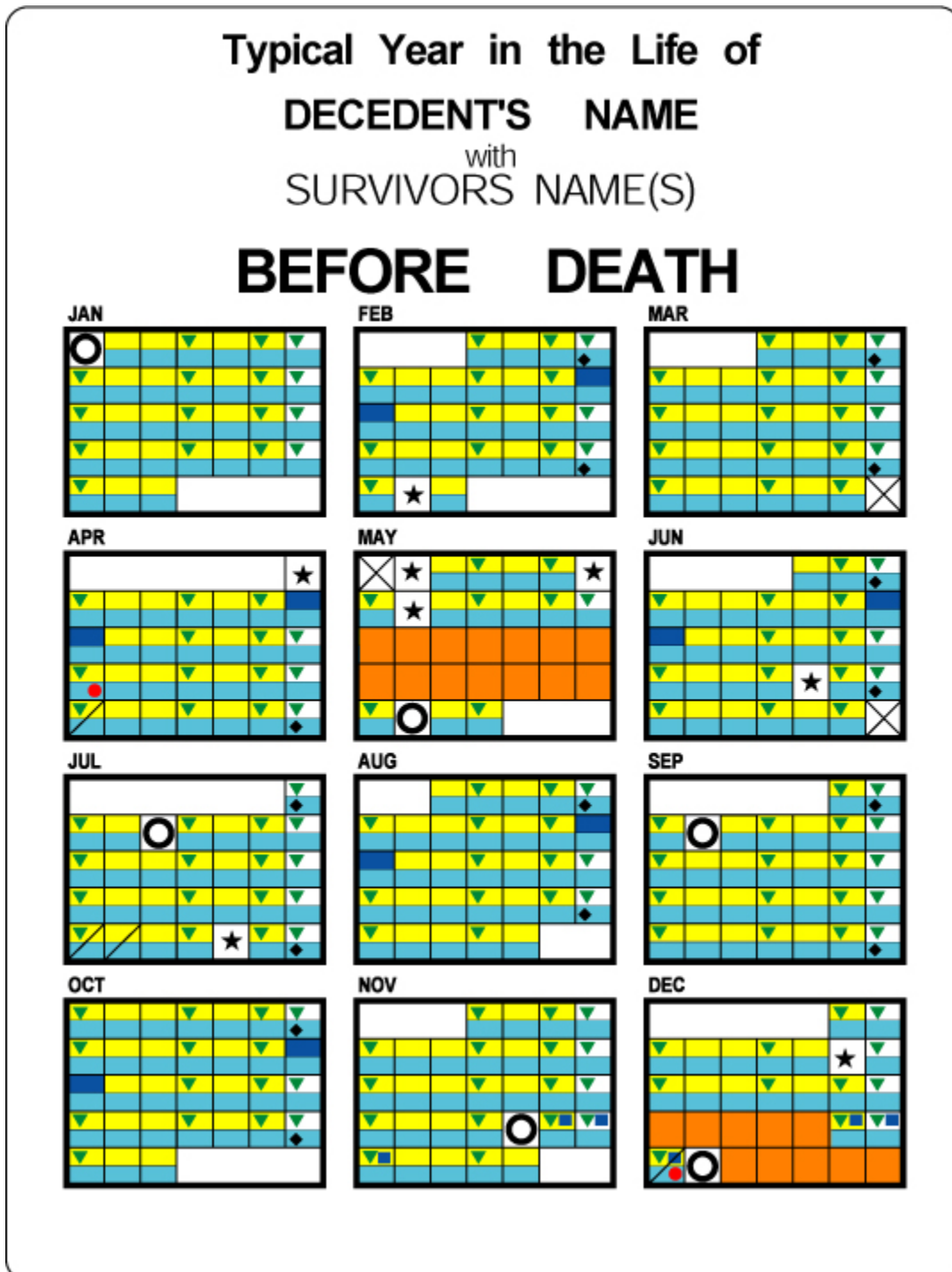
Every person engages in assorted activities in life with their loved ones – some related to work or professional responsibilities, other activities related to hobbies or personal enjoyment, and other activities related to family life and home responsibilities. The first panel (key) of the Life Activity Calendar begins by summarizing the typical activities of the decedent, with their survivors, and assigns color codes that designate those activities that are used in subsequent panels.

## Typical Activities Before Death

The second panel (before death) of the Life Activity Calendar shows a typical year, populated with the colors and symbols that illustrate the decedent's pre-death activities with their loved ones. The Calendar shows the type and frequency of activities the decedent enjoyed with the survivors in a typical year.















## Contrast After Death

A sharp, powerful and stark contrast is drawn in the third and final panel, which illustrates the total loss suffered by the survivors after the decedent's death. The profound absence of activities in the final panel fully paints the picture of total loss suffered by the survivors.
